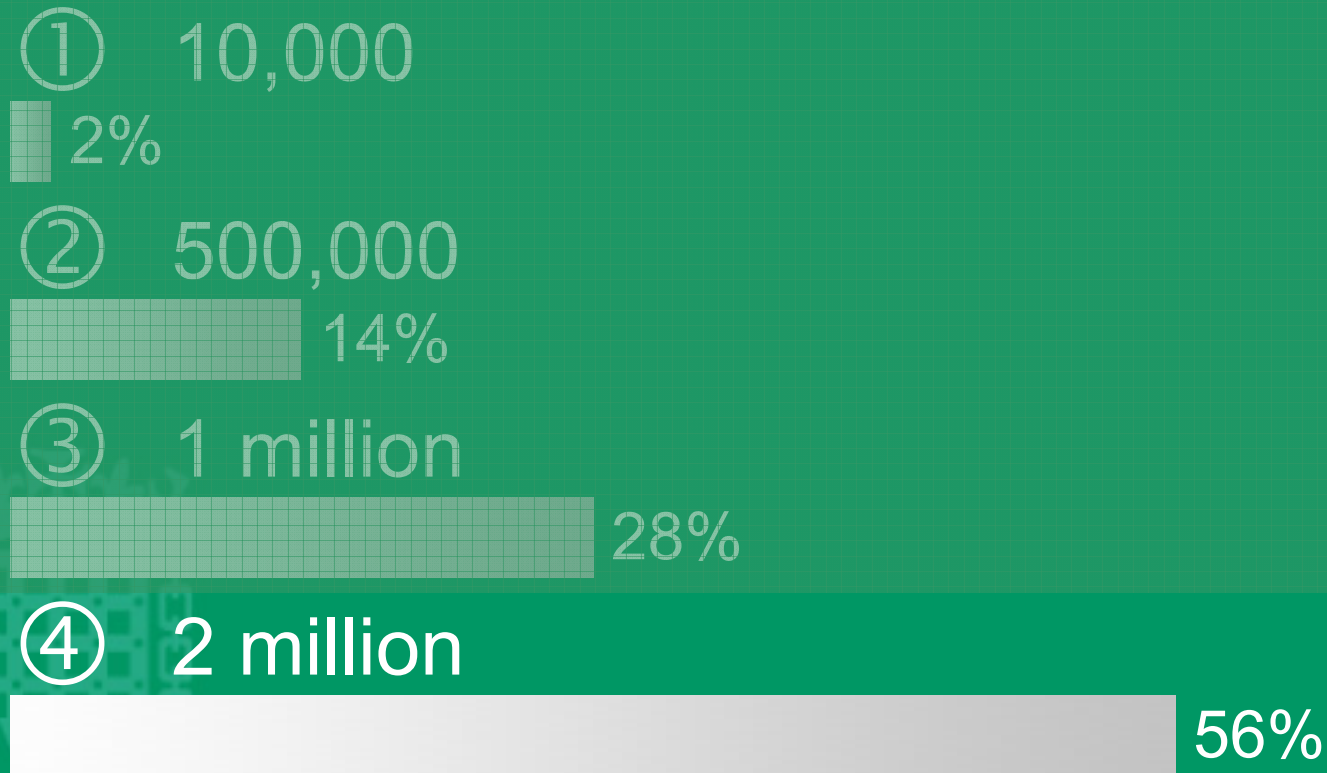
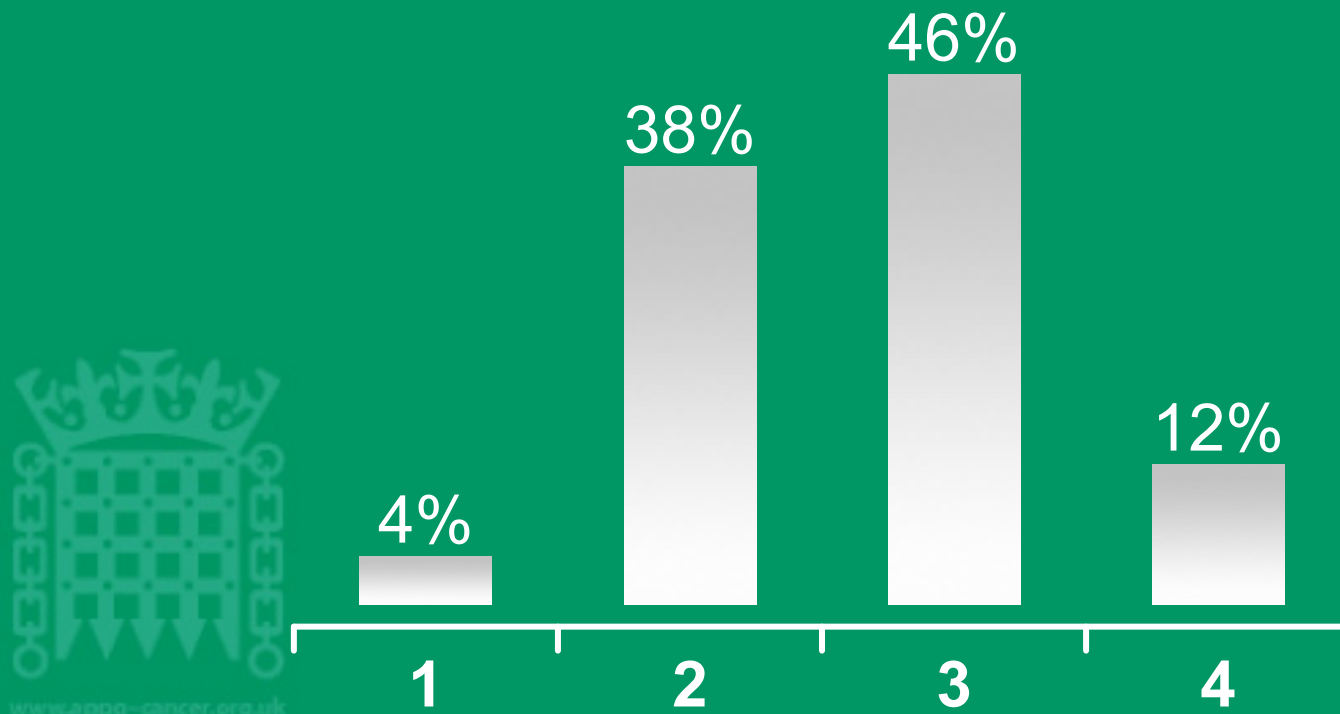


How many people are living with and beyond cancer in the UK today?

② Treatment and care



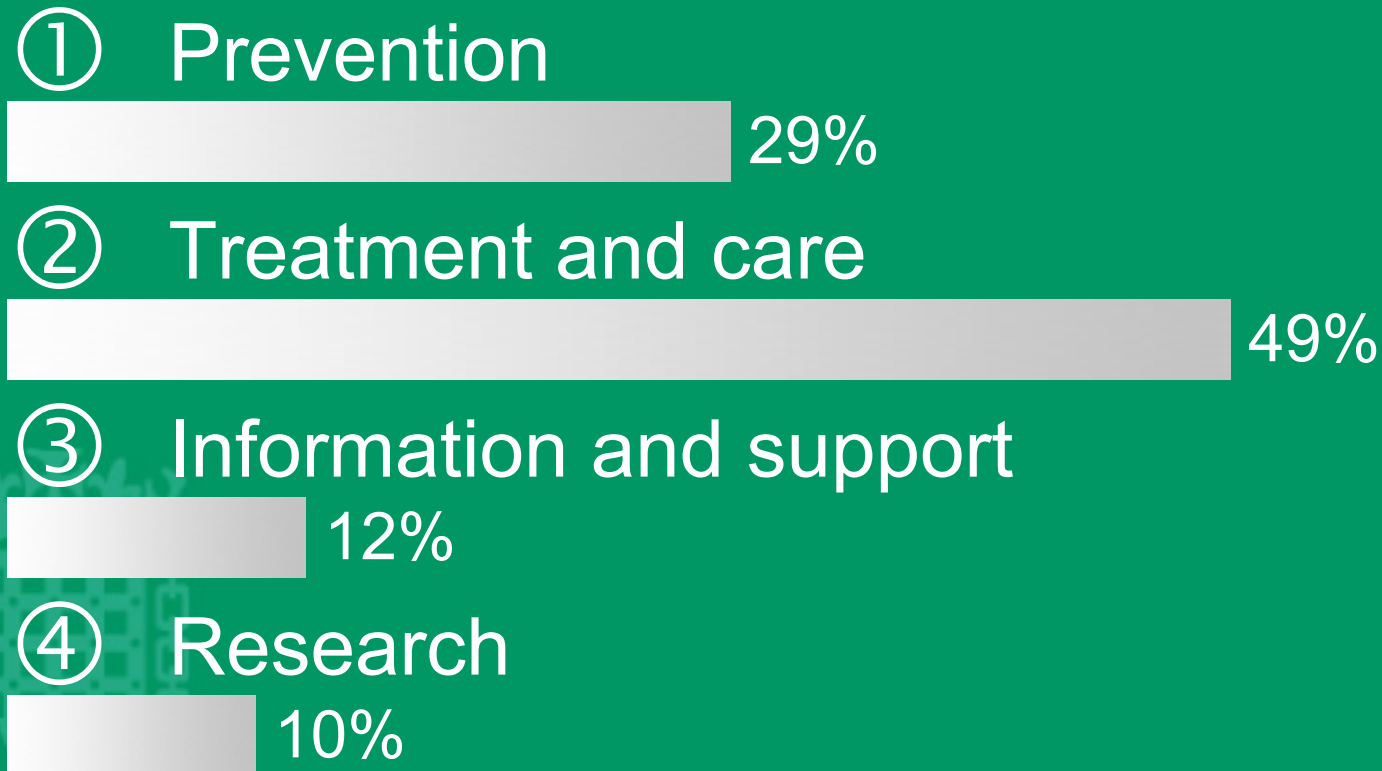

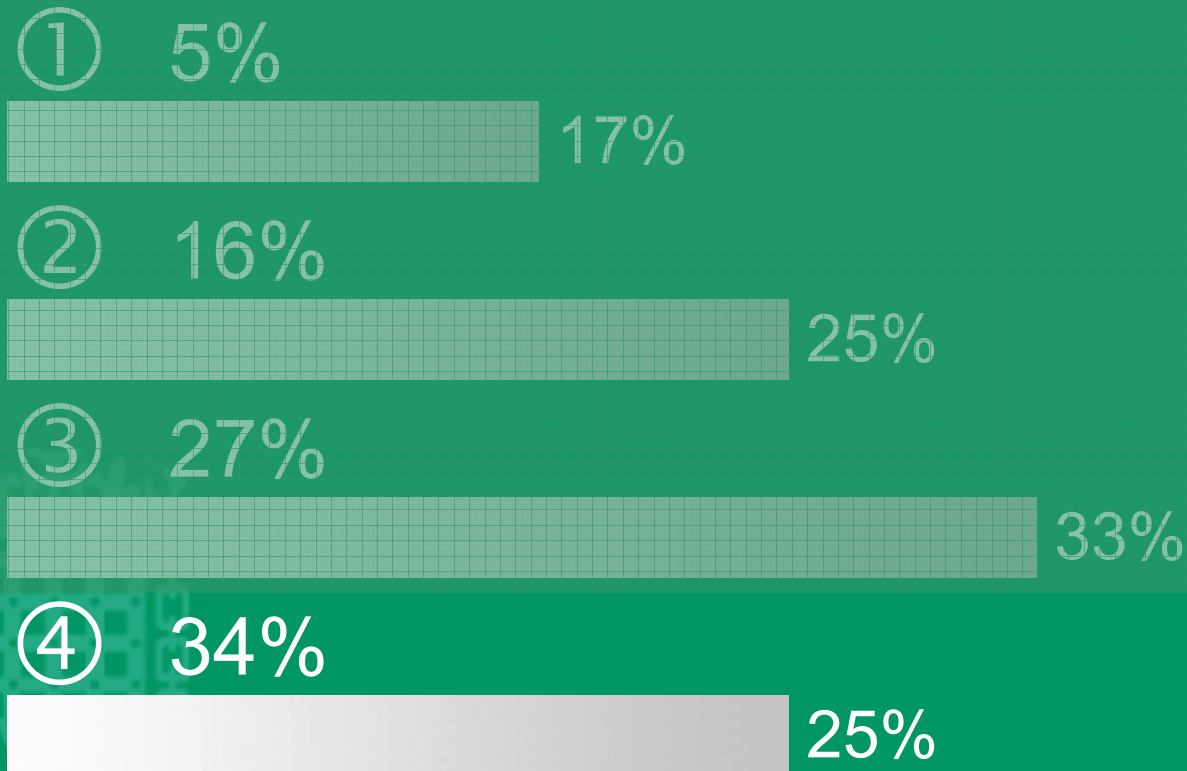
