

## Macmillan Cancer Support: Volunteer Role Description and skills profile

**Role title:** Fundraising Group member

### Why do you need me?

- Our local fundraising groups and committees raise over £100,000 annually for people affected by cancer. New members are required to help start new groups in Sheffield, Derbyshire and South Yorkshire.

### What activities will I be involved in?

- Helping to organise fundraising events with other group/committee members
- Attending group meetings
- Collecting funds on behalf of the charity

### Will I need my own transport?

- Not necessarily but access to vehicle/good transport links would be helpful to attend meetings and events.

### What skills and abilities will I need to have?

- Good communication and organisational skills
- Ability to represent Macmillan Cancer Support to members of the public.

### What are the goals?

- To raise money and awareness, and to represent Macmillan in your part of the region.
- Making a difference to your local community
- Helping people affected by cancer

### How much time should I offer?

- Flexible time commitment

### What days of the week/time of day would you need me?

- Events and meetings could take place at any time during the day or week. They are generally organised to suit group members' availability.

### Where will I be based?

- Meetings are generally held at a location within the groups area of operation

- Meeting and working with new people
- Developing your communications and organisational skills
- Having fun
- Adding to your CV
- Making a difference to your local community
- Helping people affected by cancer

### Is there an induction and training?

- Information pack and induction provided to help familiarise you with the work of the charity, the fundraising team and the current committee (if applicable)
- We will provide any training you need to complete the role

### What ongoing support/guidance will there be?

- Support from the other members of the fundraising group
- Fully supported by the Fundraising Manager, and fundraising team
- Opportunities to meet and network with staff and fellow volunteers during the year
- You will be updated on the success of the team!

### Will my expenses be paid?

- We pay volunteers' "out-of-pocket" expenses within agreed guidelines.
