WHAT IS MACMILLAN ALUMNI?

We often hear that you're proud of your work with Macmillan and would like to stay involved after your role ends. Now there's an easy way to do just that: our new Macmillan Alumni programme exclusively for previous Macmillan professionals.

Whether you've moved on to a different role or retired, Macmillan Alumni is a great opportunity to network with other cancer and palliative care professionals from across the UK and to share your knowledge and experiences.

At the same time, it allows you to stay in touch and maintain your relationship with Macmillan. By spreading our messages and providing us with valuable insights, you can continue to have a huge impact on our work for people affected by cancer.

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HOW DOES IT WORK?

The Macmillan Alumni programme is open to anyone who's leaving a Macmillan post or who has previously held one.

Simply pass on your details, including your email address, to your local Macmillan Development Manager. Or email the Macmillan Alumni team at alumni@macmillan.org.uk

We'll send you a link by email for you to register on the Macmillan Alumni network, ensuring the group is only accessible to Alumni.

You'll be invited to join the Macmillan Alumni online community, similar to LinkedIn but hosted on a secure Macmillan site. You'll also have the option of receiving regular newsletters with updates for professionals.

You'll be able to join specific interest groups based on location, professional group or subject matter. These will be led by professionals like you, with support from Macmillan.

Every year you'll be invited to a special networking event, where you can hear the latest on Macmillan's work, socialise with colleagues and friends and connect with new, like-minded people.

WHAT DOES BEING A MEMBER INVOLVE?

It's entirely up to you how much time and energy you invest as a Macmillan Alumni member. In other words, you can do as much or as little as you want. You may simply want to use the network to stay in touch with colleagues or attend events.

Or if you have the time and you're willing to do that little bit extra, you could become a Macmillan Alumni Ambassador. This involves opportunities to support us by:

- Speaking at Macmillan events
- Supporting Macmillan's media activity or talking to the public about our work
- Supporting our learning and development activities

- Promoting Macmillan's direct services
- Promoting our work locally with professionals
- Coaching and mentoring new professionals
- Getting involved in policy development, campaigning, marketing, research, service development or professional engagement.

As a Macmillan Alumni Ambassador, you choose the activities and projects that appeal most to you. We'll support you with any materials, briefings or other information you might need, and will reimburse any out-of-pocket expenses.
