Who is Tom's Gift for?

Tom's Gift is for children aged 0 to 16 living in the UK who require treatment for cancer. If you're unsure whether a child is eligible, please contact the Macmillan Grants team.

Who should complete the form?

Part one should be completed and signed by someone with parental responsibility or legal guardianship. Part two and three should be completed and signed by a health or social care professional.

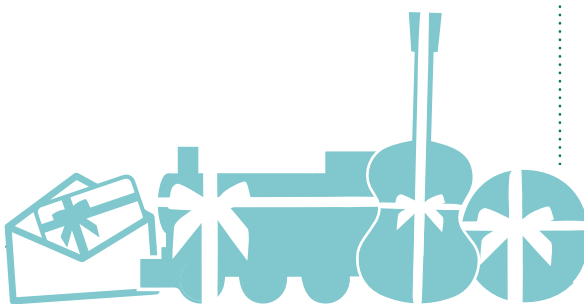

A word from **The Tom Grahame Trust**

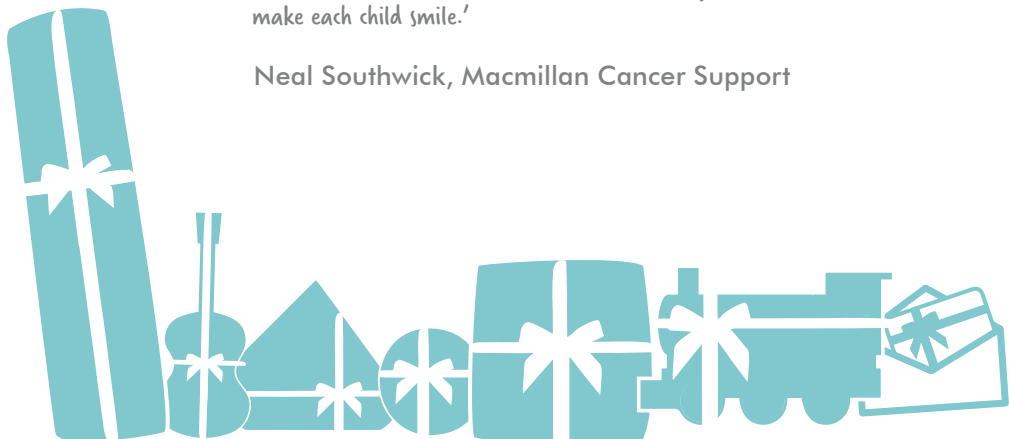
