Terms and Conditions for Entry

Marathon Yorkshire Ltd (Company No: 8295830)

1. The Plusnet Yorkshire Marathon entry fees: The entry fee for The Plusnet Yorkshire Marathon is detailed upon the entry system and will be the fee applicable at the date of submission of the entry application form.

2. Entry policy: Under UK Athletic Rules and Regulations, entrants must be at least 18 years of age on the day of the race to participate in the event.

3. Time limit: The event has a finish time limit of 7 hours and therefore we will only accept entries from participants who can complete the route within 7 hours.

4. Participants enter the event entirely at their own risk: Marathon Yorkshire Ltd will not be liable for any injury or loss occurring as a result of participation (including, without limitation, resulting from negligence), provided always that nothing in these terms and conditions shall exclude or limit our liability for death or personal injury resulting from the event organiser's negligence or for any other type of liability that cannot be excluded or limited by law.

5. Medical conditions: It is recommended that you prepare and train for this event. Please consult your doctor for a check-up if you have not exercised for some time. If you have a medical condition it must be detailed on the reverse of your race number provided. We also strongly advise that you seek medical advice before participating in this event and that you disclose to those medical advisors the nature of this event.

6. Race Numbers: Race entries are not interchangeable. Entries cannot be assigned, transferred or sold to any third party and is therefore strictly prohibited.

7. Withdrawal from event: If you are unable to take part and you do not wish to transfer to a different event, we will issue a credit after the event as follows:

- Notification dated 16 weeks (112 days) or more before the event = 50% credit
- Notification dated 12 weeks to 16 weeks (84 days to 111 days) before event = 20% credit
- Notification dated less than 12 weeks before event = nil

To receive a credit, you must notify Macmillan Cancer Support in writing by email or by post. The date of withdrawal is the date of the email or as postmarked on the envelope.

Please state clearly your full name, registration id and date of birth. This only applies where you have paid the cost of your entry.

8. No animals: With the exception of registered assistance dogs. The organisers must be advised in advance if an entrant is to be accompanied by an assistance dog.

9. Aided participants: For those participants who are aided around the course, either being pushed or assisted, the guide must also be a registered participant in the event.

10. Wheelchair entrants: It is strongly recommended that only experienced wheelchair racers attempt the race unaided.

11. For reasons of safety: No entries are permissible from participants on bikes, roller skates, in pushchairs or any kind of mechanical aid. No participants under the age of 18 years will be allowed on the course at any time.

12. Data protection: In compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 you have the right of access to your personal records held on our computer. In order to send you a race pack and fundraising pack (if requested), and produce your race results, you are authorising us to release personal details (including your full name and address) to the pack provider, charity (if applicable) and timing results company.

13. Use of image: By entering this event you give permission for the free use of your name, voice or picture in any broadcast, telecast, advertising, promotion or other medium in relation to any Yorkshire Marathon activity.

14. Baggage storage: All personal items and items of clothing may be deposited prior to the race in the designated areas. However, the race organisers and officials do not accept any responsibility whatsoever for the safe keeping or the storage of those items which are stored and deposited entirely at the risk of the participant.

15. First Aid: Adequate First Aid assistance is provided for the duration of the event. There are clearly signed First Aid points both on the course, and at the start/finish area. Please note that Volunteers and Marshals in attendance at the race are not medically trained and will not give medical assistance other than requesting an ambulance or paramedic in the event that medical assistance is required.

16. Collections: Those wishing to make a charity collection on race day will need to obtain prior written authorisation from Marathon Yorkshire Ltd. Please note that we may not be able to grant permission for collections to every request.

17. Race cancellation: If due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather or emergencies beyond our control the event is cancelled, or the distance reduced to make the event safe, there will be no refunds of entry fees and all profits will be donated to the Jane Tomlinson Appeal.

18. Change of address: You should notify the organisers and Macmillan Cancer Support of any change of address or contact details.

Marathon Yorkshire Ltd. assumes no liability in respect of the state or condition of the surface upon which the event is held and all participants should ensure that they are satisfied with the state and condition of the surface of the route before commencing the event.
