

# Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk 2014

## Terms and conditions

These terms and conditions apply to all event participants registered for both routes for the Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk. **These terms and conditions do not apply any other Macmillan walks.**

## Registration

**Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk** online registration closes at noon on **Tuesday 13th May 2014.**

Children under the age of 18 years old may participate in the event subject to parental consent and being accompanied at all times by an authorised participant (i.e. parent, legal guardian or an adult authorised by the parent or parent guardian of the child who must also register and participate at the event) at all times during the event. **If you are walking with children, please print off and complete the attached DISCLAIMER FORM which MUST be handed in at registration before the walk begins on the day.**

*Entrance to the castle is free of charge for walkers plus two supporters – please collect wristbands at desk outside the castle. These must be worn at all times. Additional supporters will be asked to pay castle entrance fee of £5 adults, £4 children.*

## Data protection and publicity

All participants, supporters and spectators, including friends and families who choose to attend the event confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage, photographs taken of them during the event to be used to publicise events held by Macmillan Cancer Support and its trading companies for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing material, television broadcasts, social media, advertising, publications, and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent;

unless the images are incidental, for example, children's images at the starting line. By registering a child of under 18 years old as an additional walker, you are confirming the under-18-year-old's parent or legal guardian is happy for their images to be used in this manner.

## Health and safety

This challenge is physically demanding. If you are unsure of your physical ability to take part in the **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk** then you must take medical advice from a general practitioner prior to the event. We recommend that you do not take part in the event if you have received medical advice not to take exercise.

We take all reasonable steps to minimise the risk of injury to participants during our fundraising events. There is a risk assessment process in place for each and every Macmillan Committee organised walking event which aims to minimise or eliminate the risk to everyone taking part. However, by taking part in this event, you acknowledge that there may be conditions or circumstances beyond our control that can lead to unforeseen risks. If you have any concerns or queries please contact us before taking part in this event. Please be aware that the event risk assessment is measured on the basis that **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk** is a non-competitive walking event and we request that no participants jog or run at the event.

**It is essential that you attend the safety briefing which takes place prior to your start time.**

For health and safety reasons participants arriving late must abide by the instructions and decisions of the Event Organisers or their representatives at the walk starting area. You are requested to contact the Event Organiser if for any reason you decide to leave the route and not finish the walk. **NB the route closes at 4.00pm.**

## Fundraising monies

All monies that you raise in connection with **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk** will be held on trust for us and therefore must be passed to us. We ask that you do this as soon as practicable after the event. You can pay in your money by:

- The easiest and simplest way to pay in your sponsorship money is through an online giving website such as Just Giving. Details of how to set up your individual fundraising page are provided in your fundraising pack.
- Pay in your money directly to a Nat West, RBS or Ulster Bank using the Bank Giro Credit slips provided in your fundraising pack on registration. - Or send cheques made payable to "Macmillan Cancer Support" along with any sponsorship forms and paying-in slip (bank giro credit) in the freepost envelope included in your fundraising pack. Please don't send cash in the post.

Please note that we are unable to accept your sponsorship money on the day of the **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk**.

## Liability

All participants, including you, enter this event entirely at their own risk and we, Macmillan, Macmillan employees and volunteers, shall not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur as a result of your participation in the Event except for death or personal injury caused as a result of our negligence or to the extent that any liability cannot be lawfully restricted or excluded by us under applicable law.

Participants' friends and family members who attend the event as supporters or spectators do so entirely at their own risk. We, Macmillan, Macmillan employees and volunteers, shall not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur as a result of their attendance at the Event except for death or personal injury caused as a result of our negligence or to the extent that any liability cannot be lawfully restricted or excluded by us under applicable law.

## General information

**The walking routes on the Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk are not suitable for wheelchair, mobility scooter, push chair/stroller, young children or anyone who has walking difficulty.**

We reserve the right to reduce or alter the **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk** routes to accommodate any unexpected complications on the day, including wet weather, which may have an impact on Macmillan Cancer Support staff, participants, volunteers and supporters.

Dogs are welcome at the **Pembrokeshire Dawn Walk**. However, to ensure that all participants are able to enjoy their day, we ask all dog owners to ensure that:

- Your dog is kept on a lead, under close control at all times, and any usual equipment (muzzle / harness etc) used to control your dog is employed on the day.
- That your dog has a collar with a clearly identifiable tag which sets out the contact details of its owner
- You bring adequate water supplies for your dog to keep them hydrated
- If your dog fouls, please 'scoop the poop'.
