

# CANCER IN ANTRIM GP FEDERATION

Antrim has the highest age-standardised incidence of leukaemia of all Northern Ireland's GP Federations.



Cancer is less common in Antrim GP Federation than in all NI.

Average cases 2011-15:

**578** New cancers in Antrim

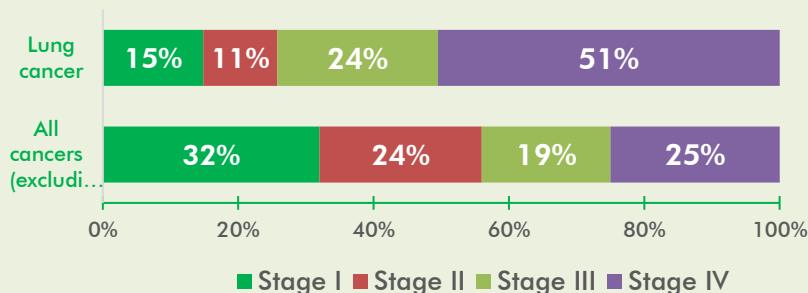
**9,073** in Northern Ireland

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Antrim GPF (2011-15)



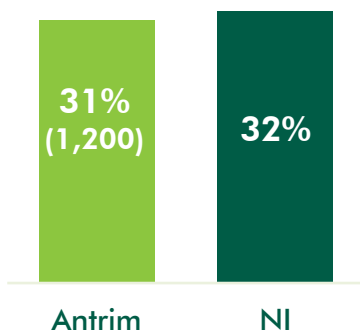
Almost two in five people (37%) living with lung cancer in the Antrim GP Federation had emergency presentations during 2015 compared to one in five (19%) across all Northern Ireland.

3,842 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
