

CANCER IN ARMAGH AND DUNGANNON GP FEDERATION



This area has by far the highest incidence of uterine cancer (38 per 100,000 compared to 30 across all NI)

Cancer is less common in Armagh and Dungannon GPF than in all NI.

497 Armagh and Dungannon GPF

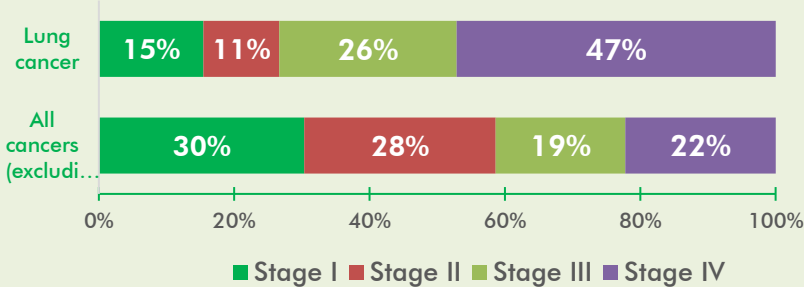

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in A&D GP Federation (2011-15)



Almost 1 in 3 lung cancer cases (32%) were diagnosed in people of working age.

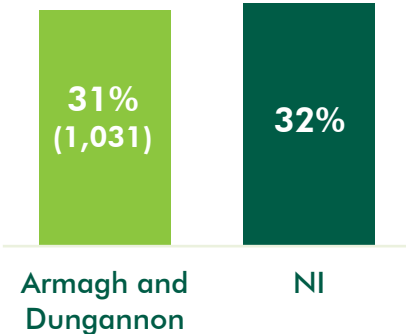
This is the highest rate of all GP Federations and significantly higher than the rate for all NI (26%).
