

CANCER IN CAUSEWAY GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of prostate cancer are significantly more common here than across all NI – the third highest of all GP Federations.



Cancer is less common in Causeway GPF than in all NI.

511 Causeway GPF

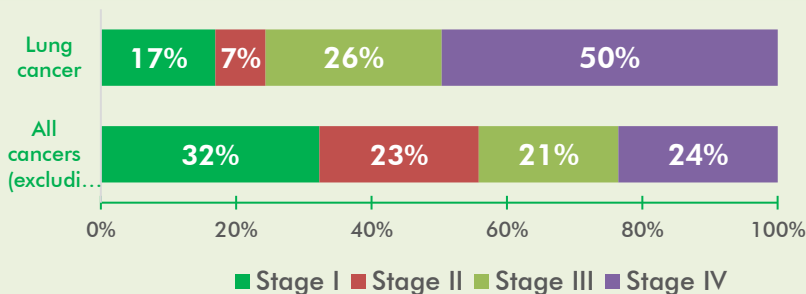

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Causeway GPF (2011-15)



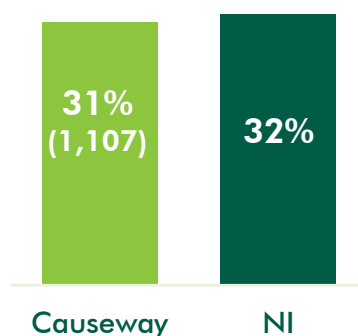
Almost half of people (48%) living with lung cancer in Causeway had emergency presentations during 2015. This is the highest rate of all GP Federations and significantly higher than the rate for all Northern Ireland (19%).

3,539 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
