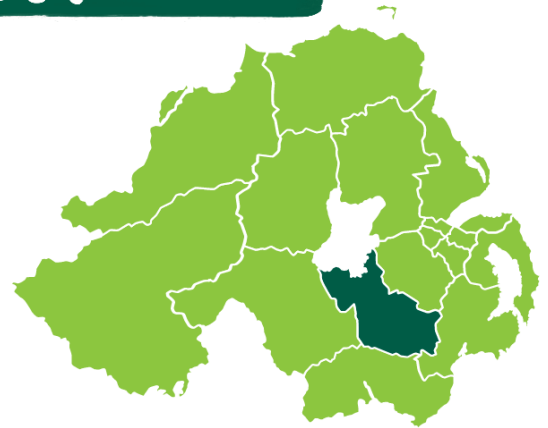


# CANCER IN CRAIGAVON GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of melanoma are significantly more common here than across all NI.



Cancer is much more common in Craigavon GPF than in all NI.

**707** Craigavon GPF

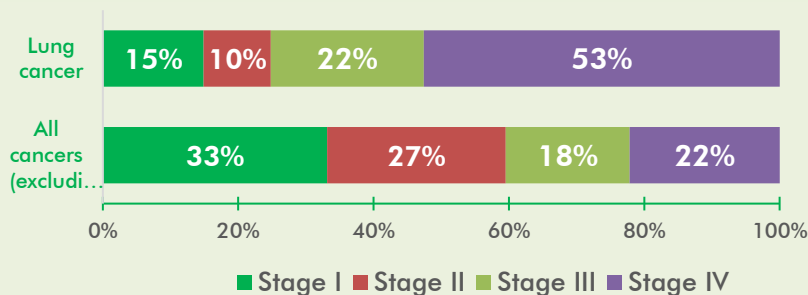
**9,073** Northern Ireland

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Craigavon GPF (2011-15)



Over 1 in 5 people (21%) living with lung cancer in Craigavon had emergency presentations during 2015.

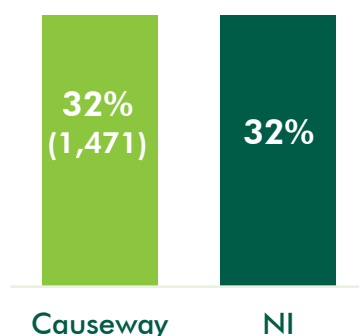
This is higher than the rate for all Northern Ireland (19%).
