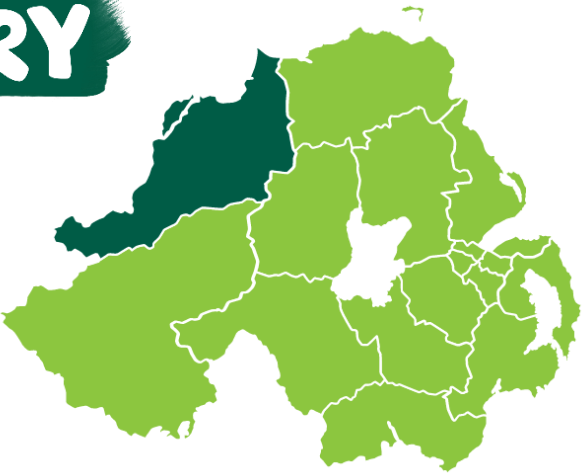


CANCER IN DERRY GP FEDERATION



- Stomach cancer is significantly more common here than across all NI.
- More than 1 in 3 colorectal cancers here (37%) were in people of working age (30% in all NI).

Cancer is less common in Derry GP Federation than in all NI.

Average cases 2011-15:

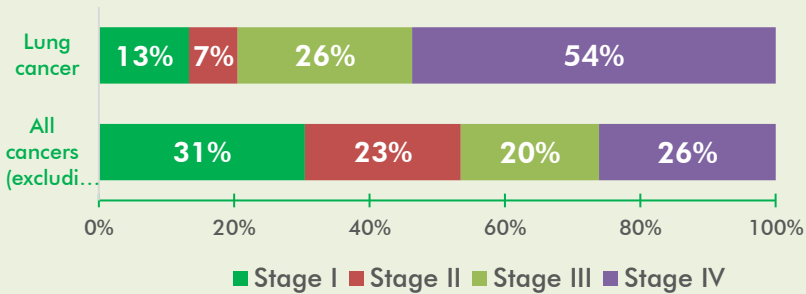

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Derry GPF (2011-15)



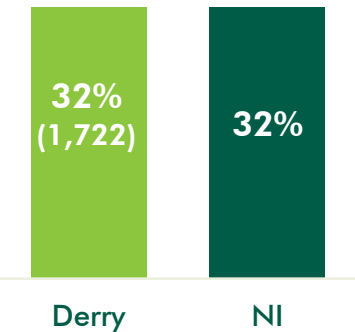
More people living with lung cancer in the Derry GP Federation were diagnosed at Stage IV (54%) than across all of NI (50%).

5,319 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
