

# CANCER IN DOWN GP FEDERATION



Between 2011 and 2015, only 45% of prostate cancers here were diagnosed at Stages I or II, compared to 55% for all of NI.

Cancer is less common in Down GP Federation than in all NI.

Average cases 2011-15:

**325** Down GPF

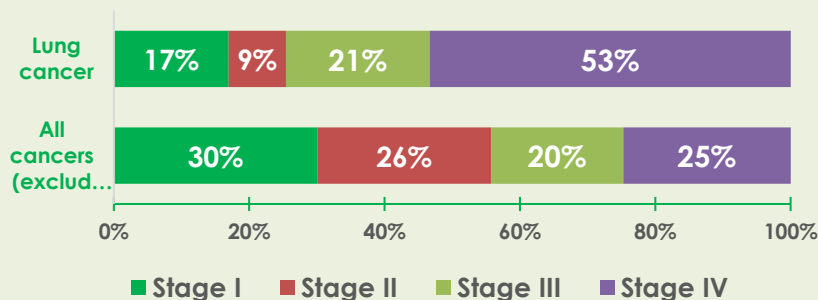
**9,073** Northern Ireland

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Down GPF (2011-15)



More than half (53%) of lung cancer cases were diagnosed at Stage IV.

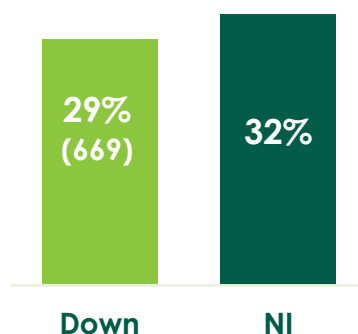
This is significantly higher than the rate for all of Northern Ireland (50%).
