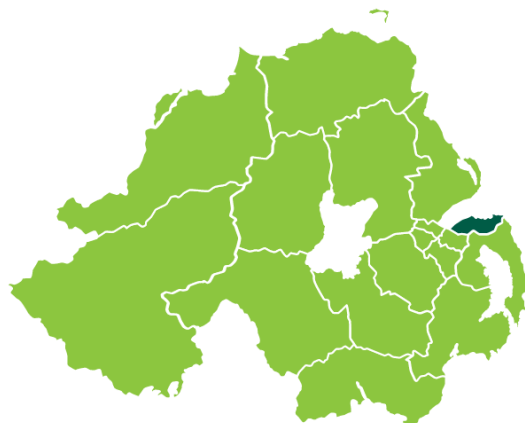


# CANCER IN NORTH DOWN GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of melanoma are significantly more common here than across all Northern Ireland.



Cancer is much less common in North Down GPF than in all NI.

**421** North Down GPF

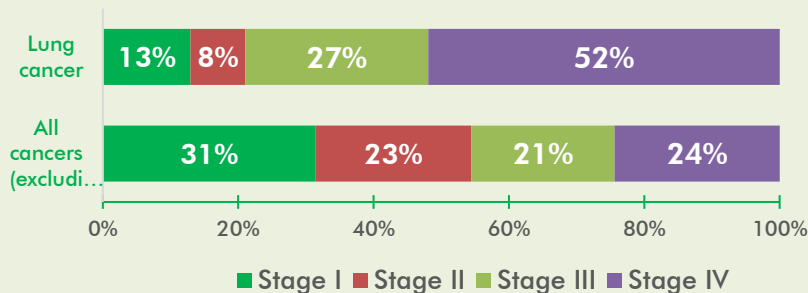
**9,073** Northern Ireland

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in North Down GPF (2011-15)



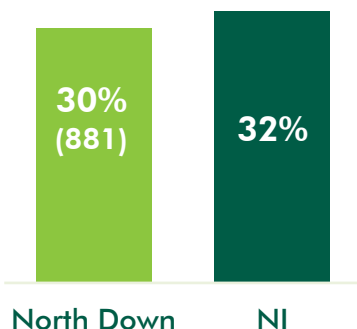
Almost 1 in 4 (24%) of people with lung cancer in North Down had emergency presentations during 2015, compared to 1 in 5 (19%) across all GP Federations in Northern Ireland.

2,933 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
