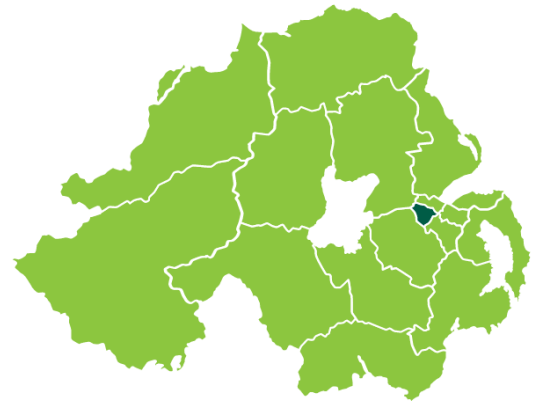


# CANCER IN WEST BELFAST GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of lung, head and neck, and cervical cancer are significantly more common here than across all NI. The incidence rate for each is higher than in all other GP Federations.

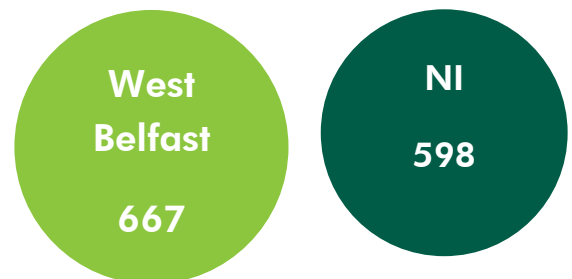


Cancer is significantly more common in West Belfast GPF than in all NI.

**393** New cancers in West Belfast

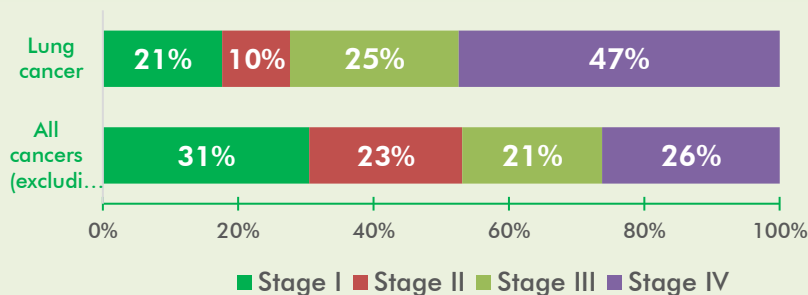
**9,073** in Northern Ireland

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in West Belfast GPF (2011-15)



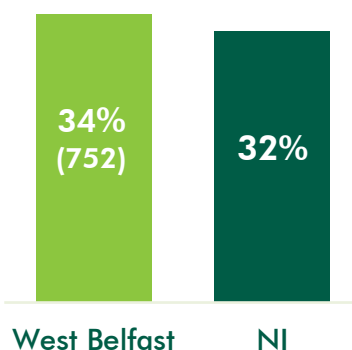
One in four people (26.4%) living with lung cancer in the West Belfast GP Federation had emergency presentations during 2015 compared to one in five (19.5%) across all Northern Ireland.

2,218 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
