


Accessing the Learning Hub

As a Member, you have already had a Learning Hub account created for you, so all you need to do is reset your password to get access to our learning materials.


To reset your password and gain access to the Learning Hub, follow this link and use the instructions below - [Access the Learning Hub](#).

- 1) Select Reset Password


- 2) Enter the email address which you have received this email (it's likely to be your Boots work email), then click Send verification code.


- 3) Enter the verification code into the verification code box on screen and select Verify Code
