

Free prize draw terms and conditions for the Mighty Hikes JustGiving prize draws (the “Prize Draws”)

By entering any of the Prize Draws, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions (“**Terms and Conditions**”). Promotional materials relating to the Prize Draws, including all information on how to enter the Prize Draws, also form part of these Terms and Conditions. In the event of any conflict between any terms referred to in any such promotional materials and these Terms and Conditions, these Terms and Conditions take precedence.

The Promoter

The promoter of each Prize Draw is Macmillan Cancer Support registered charity in England and Wales (261017), Scotland (SC039907) and the Isle of Man (604); a company limited by guarantee registered in England and Wales (02400969), Isle of Man company number 4694F. Registered office: 3rd Floor, Bronze Building, The Forge, 105 Sumner Street, London, SE1 9HZ (“**Macmillan, we, us, our**”).

Eligibility

- 2.1 To enter a Prize Draw you must be a UK resident (which comprises Great Britain and Northern Ireland, excluding the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man), aged 18 years or over and a registered participant in the relevant Mighty Hike Event in 2026 for which you are entering the Prize Draw.
- 2.2 In entering a Prize Draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. Macmillan may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the Prize Draw.
- 2.3 Macmillan will not accept Prize Draw entries that are:
 - (a) automatically generated by computer;
 - (b) completed by third parties or in bulk;
 - (c) illegible, have been altered, reconstructed, forged or tampered with;
 - (d) photocopies and not originals; or
 - (e) incomplete.
- 2.4 In addition to the above eligibility requirements, there is a limit of one entry per person per Mighty Hike Event Prize Draw. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
- 2.5 Macmillan reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Prize Draws.

How to enter

- 3.1 Each Prize Draw will run from the date on which registration for the Mighty Hike opens and the first registrants are confirmed (the "**Opening Date**") to 23:59 GMT on the applicable date, specified below, (the "**Closing Date**"):

- 3.2 Prize Draw entries must be received by Macmillan by no later than 23:59 GMT on the applicable Closing Date. Prize Draw entries received after the applicable Closing Date are automatically disqualified.

- 3.3 To enter a Prize Draw either:

- (a) set up a JustGiving page in relation to your Mighty Hike participation, update that JustGiving page story and update your JustGiving page photo. In doing this you will earn all three 'page milestone' badges; or
- (b) free entry route: Send your Prize Draw entry to Macmillan by email to mightyhikes@macmillan.org.uk, providing your name, email address and postal address.

3.4 Macmillan will **not** accept:

- (a) responsibility for Prize Draw entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any internet connection problem, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
- (b) proof of transmission as proof of Macmillan's receipt of an entry to a Prize Draw.

4.2 Prizes are subject to availability. No cash alternative will be provided. Macmillan reserves the right to substitute a prize with a prize of equal or greater value. 3rd Prize claims are subject to the provision to Macmillan of relevant JustGiving page details.

4.3 No prize is negotiable or transferable.

4.4 The prize winners will be selected by a random number generator.

Winners

5.1 The winners will be announced as soon as reasonably practicable after the applicable Draw Date (the "**Announcement Date**"). Macmillan must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation Macmillan will send the surname and county of major prize winners to anyone who emails mightyhikes@macmillan.org.uk within one month after the Closing Date of a Prize Draw.

5.2 If you object to any or all of your surname and county being published or made available, please contact Macmillan by email to mightyhikes@macmillan.org.uk. In such circumstances, Macmillan must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

Claiming the prize

6.1 With the exception of 3rd Prizes, which shall be processed by reference to relevant JustGiving pages, if you are the winner of a prize, you will have 30 days from the Announcement Date to claim the prize by responding to the prize email. With the exception of 3rd Prize claims, if you do not claim

the prize by this date, your claim will become invalid. Please also note: prizes can be posted to addresses within Great Britain only.

- 6.2 Macmillan will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner. If the winner cannot be contacted or is not available or has not claimed their prize within 30 days of the Announcement Date, Macmillan reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from eligible entries that were received before the Closing Date.
- 6.3 Macmillan does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.
- 6.4 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.

Limitation of liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, Macmillan, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of Macmillan, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
